

Triangle Scarves

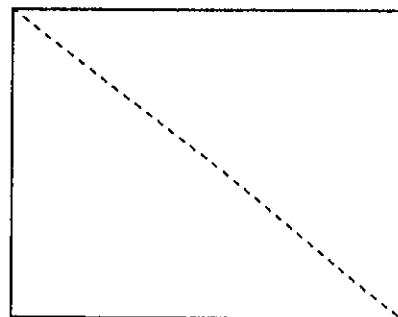
Materials

- 32 inch square of lightweight cotton fabric (no polyester!)
- Matching Thread
- (2) 3 inch x 16 inch strips of Quilt Batting
- Sewing Machine
- Scissors or Rotary Cutters

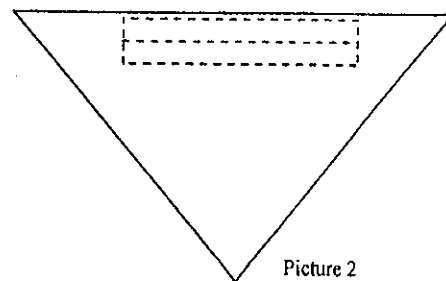
Directions

NOTE: Pattern makes two scarves.

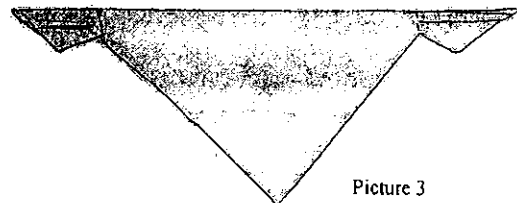
- 1) Start with a 32" square of fabric and cut the square into two triangles (picture 1).
- 2) Narrow hem the three sides of each triangle.
- 3) Cut (2) 3 inch x 16 inch strips of quilt batting (one for each triangle).
- 4) Place batting on the long side of the triangle (WRONG side of fabric) and fold (WRONG side of fabric together) to encase the quilt batting.
- 5) Stitch through the middle of the batting along the right side of fabric, along the hemmed edge and on the short sides of batting (picture 2).
- 6) Pleat scarf (3-4 folds) 8½ inches from each end and stitch in place (picture 3).
